

Shield Removal

- 1. Open the shield to its maximum open position. Do not force.
- 2. Grasp the shield, then pull it upward in the direction of the arrow, free of the base-plate channel.
- 3. The shield will be automatically released out of the base ratchet mechanism.









Shield Installation

- 1. Align the visor with the base-plate channel.
- The shield should be in an open or upward position for proper alignment. The shield should slide within the base-plate channel to a full stop.
- 3. Close the shield.









Visor Installation

- Align the visor with the base-plate channel. The visor should be in an open or upwards position for proper alignment.
- 2. Slide the visor in the direction of the arrow within the base-plate channel to a full stop.







Visor Removal

- Open the visor to its maximum open position. Do not force.
- 2. Grasp the visor, then pull it upward in the direction of the arrow, free of the base-plate channel.
- 3. The visor will be automatically released out of the base ratchet mechanism.










Cheek Pad Removal

There are 2 snaps and a Velcro holding the cheek pad in place.

- 1. Gently pry the cheek pad's plastic sleeve away from the interior.
- 2. Grasp the cheek pad near its center and gently pull it free from the chin strap, releasing the snaps.





Cheek Pad Installation

- 1. Feed the chin straps through the opening in the cheek pad.
- 2. Force the cheek pad's plastic sleeve in between the shell and EPS.
- 3. Align 2 cheek pad snaps and Velcro, and press the snaps together, starting with Velcro first.
